The papyri of Greco-Roman Egypt are one of ancient history's still growing source categories. Nevertheless, modern syntheses on the material remain a major desideratum, since most papyrologists focus on editing and annotating the still unedited papyri. This seminar tries to give an impression of the perspectives and opportunities of writing history from the papyri. For this purpose, Hermupolis Magna, a town in middle Egypt and the third greatest trove of papyrological discoveries besides the Faiyum oasis and the town of Oxyrhynchus, will serve as an example for the treasures still waiting for their historical analysis.
