Professor Gerald K. LeTendre is co-editor of The American Journal of Education and has served in many editorial positions in other academic journals. He will share with students his insights on evaluating journal quality, the review process in journals and how to publish in major education journals in English. He will share some strategies and recommendations for academic writing and evaluating quality of papers' abstracts.
